Unveiling the Heart of the Psalms

The title of this devotional book, "*Unveiling the Heart of the Psalms*," was revealed to us by the Lord to delve deeper into the teachings of this powerful book, which contains prophetic doctrinal teachings that edify both the soul and the spirit.

The Book of Psalms can be used for creating a devotional book applicable to the personal situations of believers—whether emotional, family-related, or communal. However, the Psalms, like all of the Scriptures, were not given for that purpose alone, but rather so that we might immerse ourselves in the Word of God, in the teachings given by the Holy Spirit to know God, to grow in that knowledge, and to know the Lord's Eternal Kingdom—something that produces deep joy expressed through worship and praise.

The Perverse, the old man, and Satan have deceived believers in the Church, leading them to believe that the Bible is a manual of instructions for living on this Earth, or a book meant to fulfil all earthly desires and plans. However, this is not the Word of God, for it leads us to set our eyes and our hearts on heavenly things and to long for the New Jerusalem. Colossians 3:1-4 says:

¹ If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. ² Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. ³ For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. ⁴ When Christ *who is* our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.

Now more than ever, believers must long to go to the Father's house; we must cry out and groan for the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ for His holy Church to arrive at the New Jerusalem. Therefore, we must love God's Word, desire it with all our hearts, and long to understand it. For this reason, it is necessary to search it, study it, and meditate on it day and night, as David affirms in Psalm 1:2.



It is with this eternal perspective that we must approach and immerse ourselves in the Psalms, for in them we come to know in detail the Redemptive work of Christ, the eternal promises, the Millennial Kingdom, the Eternal Kingdom, the judgements of God, among other powerful truths that ignite the fire of the Holy Spirit in our hearts.

We will navigate the deep waters of power and joy found in the Psalms through these devotionals, which lead us to desire to do the will of God and not our own will—devotionals that keep us within the Daydream of our Beloved, our Lord Jesus Christ.
