

THE LORD'S ETERNAL COVENANTS DISCIPLESHIP

INTRODUCTORY STEP

God bless you! Welcome to this discipleship, "The Lord's Eternal Covenants," which is connected to the discipleship "The Eternal Promises of the King." In the latter, we studied the attributes of God that uphold the promises and the biblical covenants established by our Almighty God. We already know these covenants and promises, and we have the certainty and conviction that God will fulfill them, since they rest upon His eternal and immutable attributes.

However, in this discipleship we will study each covenant individually, in detail and in depth. It is necessary for the Church to remember that God entered covenant with humanity to give them the opportunity to enter His presence and to obtain the eternal inheritance which He has reserved in the new creation, the New Heavens and the New Earth. And we say that this is necessary because, in most churches throughout the world, the covenants and their promises have been forgotten; they are regarded as an ancient story, already past, with neither validity nor application for the present time.

- Why do you think most churches do not believe in God's covenants and promises?: Because they have forgotten the covenants and the promises, regarding them as something of the past. Most churches have apostatized from the faith, abandoning the Word of God; they have set their eyes and their hearts on this earth and seek only material possessions, the glory of men, the desires of the Wicked One, the flesh, and the old man.


It is astonishing that there is so much unbelief when the promises of God are so clearly revealed in the Scriptures; it is evident that they are eternal, that they have not yet been fulfilled, and that God is faithful and true; therefore, He will fulfill every covenant and every promise He has made when we meet the requirements He demands.

And these requirements are granted to us by the Father Himself through His Son Jesus Christ, who finished His redemptive work in order to remove the hindrance to the

fulfillment of the covenants and the reception of all His promises. In Discipleship 1 of “The Eternal Promises of the King,” we learned that there are two hindrances.

Can you remember them? Write them down:

- Hindrance 1 to the fulfillment of the covenants and the promises: sin.
- Hindrance 2 to the fulfillment of the covenants and the promises: death.
- Where and when did these two hindrances arise? They arose in Eden, when Adam sinned, as described in Genesis 3.
- Who removes these two hindrances, and why?: The Lord Jesus Christ, because He was born, lived, and died without sin; He never sinned and carried out the redemptive work on our behalf—His substitutionary work—since He took our place to deliver us from sin and from death, when He raises us and glorifies our body.
- Do you remember this image from Step 5 of the discipleship “The Eternal Promises of the King”? (If you do not remember it, review the step.): Yes.



- Explain the image in your own words (Use the first person “I”): **When I was without Christ, I was in sin, and this separated me from the Eternal Kingdom, from the New Jerusalem, and from the Lord’s eternal promises.**
- Do you remember this other image from Step 5 of the discipleship “The Eternal Promises

of the King"? (If you do not remember it, review the step.): Yes.



- Explain the image in your own words (Use the first person "I"): When I repented of all my sins and received Christ into my heart, He cleansed me from sin and gave me the hope of eternal life; I became a child of God and received the guarantee of the eternal inheritance: the Holy Spirit. Therefore, I will have entrance into the New Jerusalem and will receive all the eternal promises.

In this Discipleship, we will study the eight following covenants:

- (1) the Edenic Covenant,
- (2) the Adamic Covenant,
- (3) the Noahic Covenant,
- (4) the Abrahamic Covenant,
- (5) the Covenant of the Law,
- (6) the Land Covenant,
- (7) the Davidic Covenant; and
- (8) the New Covenant.

With Adam




On which day did God create man?
